## Dear Conferees:

In anticipation of the House-Senate conference committee on the fiscal 2005 defense authorization bill (HR 4200), we urge the conferees to retain the House position on the number of US military personnel that can be assigned to Colombia.

The troop cap amendment offered by Representative Gene Taylor won strong bipartisan approval in committee and reflects a reasonable increase that will not place undue strain on US military personnel.

Moreover, we do not believe that increased U.S. military involvement in Colombia's civil conflict is in the United States' best interest. According to General Richard Cody our troops are already "stretched thin." Further militarization of aid to Colombia hurts US military readiness across the globe.

Additionally, the Colombian Government has already received billions of dollars in aid over the last four years and should be taking steps to increase their responsibility for their own internal conflict. Before we continue to expand our commitment to Colombia, we should ensure that we are actually training Colombians to take on this responsibility and not commit our forces to becoming entrenched in yet another open ended conflict.

We therefore urge you, as conferees, to work to ensure that the House position prevails in conference.
